Dear Parent,

As the parent of an incoming 6th, 7th or 8th grader at the Halsted Middle School, we wanted to make sure you are aware that your child is eligible to participate in a FREE afterschool enrichment program: **Project Launch Newton**.

The Project Launch Newton Afterschool Program is open to all Halsted Middle School students. Activities take place separately for 5th & 6th grade and 7th & 8th grade on school grounds, and students have the option to be bused home. The program runs Monday through Friday from school closing until 5:45 p.m., with additional field trips and other activities on weekends as scheduled. Daily snacks are provided along with physical and educational enrichment activities centered around the theme of STEM: Science, Technology, Engineering and Math.

Project Launch Newton will begin on September 14, 2015. Many of your fellow 7th and 8th grade families have already enrolled in the program. We hope you will join them! Simply complete the attached enrollment packet and return it to the school office by Friday, June 19th to ensure that your child can participate. Not ready or sure you want to join Project Launch Newton? No problem – your child can still enroll at any point during the school year, but of course we encourage you to start the program as soon as possible to get the most benefit from it.

As always, our goal is for Project Launch to be a fun and enriching experience which empowers students to be their best selves in all aspects of their lives – academically, in extracurricular activities, and as engaged members of their communities. Parent involvement is welcome and encouraged. We plan to continue all of the great things we did in Project Launch this year for the 2015-2016 school year including the MicroSociety curriculum, Girls on the Run, Rachel's Challenge, lots of great field trips, and special attendance incentives. Project Launch is purposefully integrated with our school's extracurricular activities, so it is expected that student-athletes and club members will join Project Launch as well.
